# **Believe It Or Not, The Turntable Is Moving Forward. Hip, Hip Hooray!**

The much needed 'sequence of construction' and electrical plans were completed and submitted to the City of Fillmore by our civil engineer. These were the last two items required by Willdan, the grant administrator, for us to go out to bid with contractors for the turntable installation. "Willdan received them from the City on August 23rd and forwarded them to our Construction Manager, Ron Wilson for backchecking on August 24. Ron met with us on August 25th to give us a brief overview of initial impressions and he will be forwarding review comments by the end of this week", said Willdan representative Roxanne Hughes. "He also indicated that he would be contacting Edison to confirm/clarify information shown on the electrical plan. An immediate issue was that the electrical power had changed from the previously provided information and he wanted to establish which is correct".

This is Willdan's FIRST chance to review of all of the electrical details and added information. So they need a chance to look over the information thoroughly and follow up on any loose ends. "We are working to get you out to bid", said Hughes.

The turntable was acquired by the Society in 1997. It was refurbished and the motor rewound. The federal grant was approved in June of 2004 and it is estimated to take four (4) months from the time the bid is awarded until construction is done.
