ROUND THE ROUNDHOUSE

VCTC - The Ventura County Transportaton Commission contributed \$750.00 to the Society Car Attendants for their efforts toward passenger safety as Ambassadors aboard Metrolink Fair Trains. Society members manned two different Metrolink trainsets for two weekends during the annual Ventura County Fair. Our thanks go to VCTC for feeding our crews and providing complimentary Fair admission tickets.

GRANT FUNDS APPROVED - The Society, with the cooperation of the County of Ventura and the City of Fillmore, have secured some \$700,000 in Economic Development Agency funds for 'hardscape' elements of the Railroad Interpretive Center (RIC) Project. The monies will be used for the installation of required storm drains, curbing, electrical, sewers, and a concrete extension of the promenade along the north track as well as installation of the turntable. The Society must produce some \$66,000. in matching funds to secure the grants. Thanks to the continuing efforts of our volunteers and generous donations, the Society RIC project account contains just enough to meet these grant requirements. Remember, all donations are tax deductible.

PUMPKIN PATCH - Over five (5) weekends in October Society members unloaded and scattered pumpkins, handled pumpkin patch sales, arranged for a 4-H petting zoo, manned the Fillmore & Western pumpkin trains, and sold ice cold sodas. We sold so many sodas that the sodas alone netted \$1,175. Final proceeds to be shared with the F&W are estimated to net the Society some \$3,000 - \$4,000 after expenses. Thank you F&W for the opportunity to participate and the Thursday night BBQ dinners!

RIVERSIDE METROLINK - On November 13th some 25+ Society 'railroaders' journeyed on Metrolink from Santa Clarita to Union Station to San Bernardino and across a "\$5.00 track" to Riverside and return. Scanners blaring, our unofficial tour guide Jeff Tremble, pointed out all the places of interest. 
